The Holy Cross tradition of operating a school and teaching began in post-revolutionary France over 160 years ago. Blessed Father Basil Moreau C.S.C., founder of the Brothers of Holy Cross believed the vocation of a teacher was a special call from God as important as God's call to the religious life. He believed true education consisted in forming the hearts of young people and that the first duty of a teacher was to develop Christians. Ultimately, Father Moreau believed knowledge and scholarship are of great importance but only if placed in the context of moral values.

Today the Brothers of Holy Cross operate Holy Cross of San Antonio along with 15 other high schools throughout the United States along with several universities, most notably The University of Notre Dame.

Holy Cross of San Antonio in its fifty-first year of operation continues to provide its students with a tried and proven educational philosophy. A philosophy that has at its core the belief that all students can succeed academically, builds on student's moral foundation, develops their relationship with God, provides a challenging but inclusive college preparatory curriculum, and instills a fundamental sense of respect and pride.
